## 'u-e' Spelling Find and Sink Game

## You will need:

- My Words Grid and Enemy Words Grid (one of each per person)
- Pencil


## Instructions:

Play this game in pairs. Each player marks their My Words grid with four ' $u$-e' words. Two 4 letter ' $u$-e' words, a five letter ' $u$ - $e$ ' word and a six letter ' $u-e$ ' word. The first player calls out a grid position using the letters and numbers, like B5. The other player either says hit or miss depending if their word is there. Mark the square on your Enemy Words grid with H for hit or M for miss. Only have one shot at a time. Once you have hit all the letters in your partner's word, they will read it to you and you must spell it. If you spell it correctly the ship sinks. If you spell it incorrectly, your partner gets to write the word back into their grid in another area.

Keep playing until all of one person's words have sunk.
